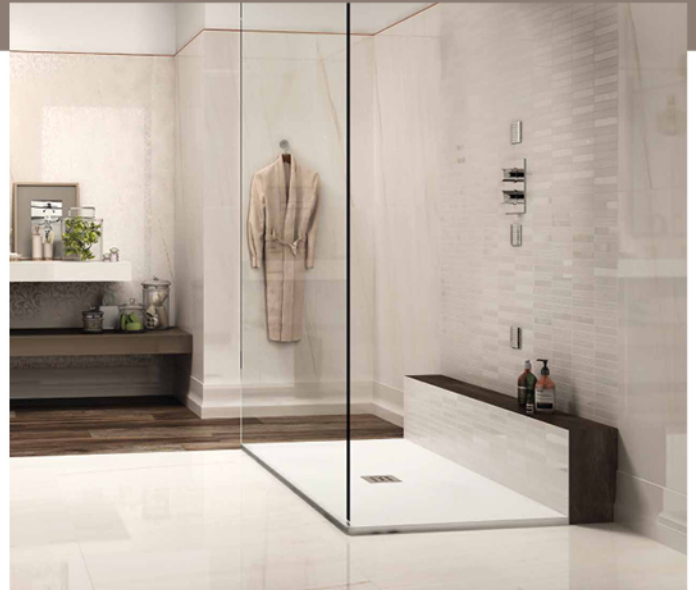


# NATURAL STONE TILES - CARE & MAINTENANCE GUIDE

## CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR NATURAL STONE TILES PURCHASE!

To ensure you reap the full benefits of this beautiful product we have compiled a list of care essentials and maintenance tips.

Please read the below and if you need any additional information, we are happy to assist further.



### GENERAL

All natural stone tiles must be sealed, regardless of their finish, and maintained properly. All natural stone finishes look beautiful and are durable when protected through sealing, maintained, and treated properly.

Please bear in mind that sealing natural stone will make it stain resistant, but not stain-proof. Sealing will delay the penetration of liquid into materials, not prevent it.

### TIPS FOR TILE MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

- Sweep or vacuum your natural stone floor regularly. Should you prefer vacuuming, you need to ensure that the vacuum wheel or attachments are not worn out, to avoid scratches.
- Wash your natural stone floor with lukewarm clean water. Use a pH-neutral tile cleaner, like the Stone Wash that is available at WOMAG.
- Important: Always sweep or vacuum your natural stone floor first before washing, and do not reuse dirty water.
- Never use cleaners that contain acid on natural stone.
- Always protect the stone from sand and grit. Using doormats is a good idea.
- Tend to a spill quickly – contain the spill by blotting it with a clean dry cloth or towel. Avoid wiping the area as it will disperse the spill.
- Do not let excessive water dry on the stone.

### SEALING YOUR STONE

- All-natural stone must be sealed using a sealant specifically formulated for use on natural stone.

*How to Seal:*

- Follow the instructions on the bottle.
- Make sure the stone is clean and dry.
- Spread evenly.
- Don't walk on the surface for 12 to 24 hours.
